

Who may register for the library?

Everybody! Children or young people up to the age of 16 need the approval of a parent or a guardian.

How can you (and/or your child) register?

- You come in person.
- You bring a valid ID card (or a passport together with a Certificate of Registration) and sign the application.
- You register online via self-registration at www.erfurt.de/bibliothek.

Who is exempted from paying the annual fee?

- Children and pupils with valid student card,
- Kindergartens, schools and non-profit institutions,
- People who are volunteering for the library (with contract).

What are the lending periods?

- Principally: four weeks,
- for music cds, dvds, videos and journals just one week!

How can you renew the lending period of your lent media?

- Personally in the library or
- via phone, email or at: www.opac.erfurt.de

What else do you need to know?

- You can renew the lending period for your lent media up to three times as long as they are not reserved.
- Check the media for completeness and damage before you lend them.
- Lent media must not be borrowed to a third party.
- The library is not liable for any damages caused by lent media.

What else do you need to consider?

- The Library Card is not transferable.
- Changes of names or addresses as well as a loss of the Library Card should immediately be reported to the library. In cases of misuse the card holder will be made liable!
- You can only borrow media if you hold a personal Library Card. You must not use the card of another person!
- With a preschooler card you may only borrow specifi-cally indicated media.

And finally an important advice:

You are responsible for complying with lending periods and copyrights, applying for extension of the lending period or respectively the correct and complete return of the lent media. The library users are responsible for the necessary diligence and care. Please contact the library in any cases of doubt.
